## **JENNIFER OWENS CREATES HAVEN OF QUIET ELEGANCE AT WESTON DESIGNER SHOWHOUSE**

When interior designer Jennifer Owen of Stratford was given the challenge of decorating the master bedroom suite at the Weston Designer Showhouse, she immediately thought 'Zen'. " I felt that the space needed to be transformed into a soothing retreat ", she said, "and although I've utilized soft, serene colors such as taupe and cocoa brown, celadon green, soft blue and ivory, I've also introduced artwork, fabrics and furnishings that bring vitality and life into the room as well ". Owen, who has had her own interior design business for the past ten years, is now associated with Exciting Windows! – a national company. She will continue to offer her classic, elegant decorating style – with an added focus on custom window treatments and accessories. Her passion for fabrics, colors and mixing traditional well-bred furnishings with neoclassic and contemporary lines is evident in this master bedroom suite – where she has used unexpected elements to give the room a sense of upscale grandeur without it being overdone.

The centerpiece of the space is the clean line of a headboard and framed bed fully upholstered in silk celadon tones and dressed impeccably with Irish linens. Owen pulled colors from the upholstery fabric and selected a large contemporary area rug with a geometric design in tones of soft green, taupe and ivory. A combination of sheer color blocked linen soft pleated draperies combined with white shutters creates an electric style at the window bringing a clean, contemporary edge to the room. The walls in the master bedroom are finished in venetian-plaster created with three layers that provide a sheen, textured finish and neoclassic dresser with polished chrome hardware, coordinated satin sheen wool upholstered chairs in a soft celadon color and plaid cashmere throw. The contemporary brushed chrome lamps with tone on tone soft grey silk shades complete the peaceful space. Coordinated colors, fabrics and styling extend to the master bathroom and toilets with a soft palette of horizontal striped walls in both toilets and a contemporary leaf stencil on the walls in the master bath. Onto the patio with textured celadon and

taupe cushions on wrought iron chairs coordinate with a round table, conducive to outside entertaining. Potted fall plants adorn the entire area.
